Conwy Culture Centre

We are excited to announce that work will begin on the new Conwy Culture Centre in 2018. The Centre will house the area library for Conwy, Deganwy and Llandudno Junction together with the county Archive and Museum Collections, interactive displays and a dedicated community and arts space.

Over the last year the project team have been raising funds and getting planning permission in place. Following Cabinet approval in December 2017 the building work was put out to tender and work is due to start in May on site at the junction of Town Ditch and Bangor Road in Conwy. The Centre is scheduled to open in autumn 2019.

What will it look like?



The design shows a contemporary single storey building offering stunning views towards Conwy Castle and Walls. The green roof will blend into Bodlondeb Park's leafy surroundings and its landscaped grounds will feature an external reading court and garden.
